

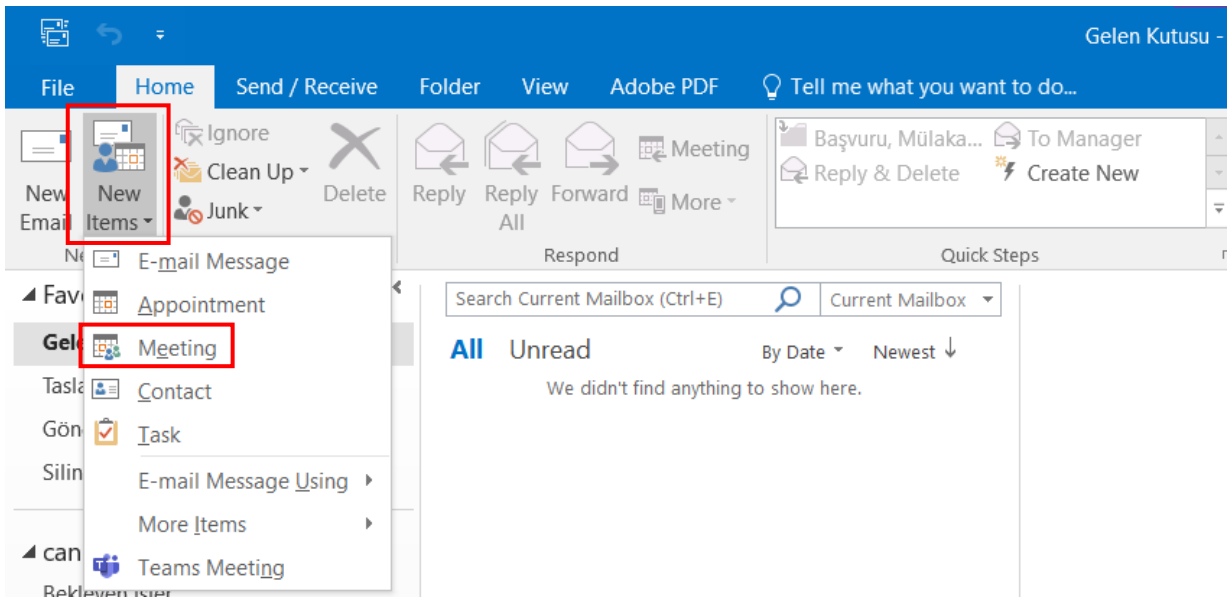


GRADUATE PROGRAMS ONLINE THESIS MONITORING/DEFENSE GUIDE

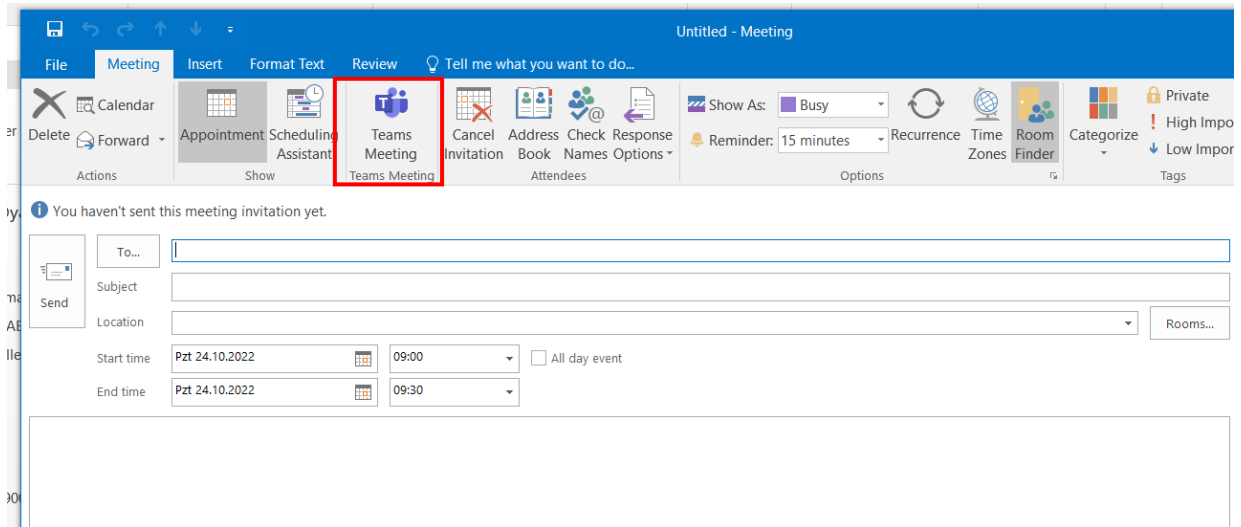
Yaşar University, Graduate School (GS) Master's (thesis), PhD and Proficiency in Arts Programs, thesis defenses, PhD thesis proposal and thesis monitoring meetings; can be done online using Microsoft Teams. In cases where online meetings are held in environments such as Zoom, Google Meet etc. these services can also be used, provided that the meeting is recorded and a cloud link is added to the relevant form.

A. CREATING THE INVITATION TO THE MEETING BY THE ADVISOR AND INVITING THE STUDENT/JURY/COMMITTEE MEMBERS TO THE MEETING

1. The advisor who created the meeting invitation goes to the meeting creation page by clicking on the “New Items” option through the Microsoft Outlook application and using the “Meetings” option.



2. Click the “Teams Meeting” option in the window that opens.





3. In the window that opens, there is a meeting link in the text “Click here to join the meeting” in the mail content, and Meeting ID and Passcode information, if necessary, just below. The e-mail address of the participants who will attend the thesis monitoring/defense should be written in the box that says “To”. The subject of the meeting should be written in the “Subject” box. Meeting start and end details can be selected as date and time. Advanced options for the meeting can be accessed by clicking on the “Meeting Options” option.

4. When the “Meeting Options” button is clicked, the following page opens. “Who can bypass the lobby?” option can be selected as “Everyone”. In order for screen shares to be open to all participants, the “Who can present?” option can still be selected as “Everyone”. The use of microphone and camera, the “Chat” part is automatically assumed to be enabled. Meeting settings can be changed according to the advisor’s preferences. After the changes are made, the settings are saved with the “Save” button. If the “Send” button is clicked, the meeting invitation is sent to the participants as an e-mail.

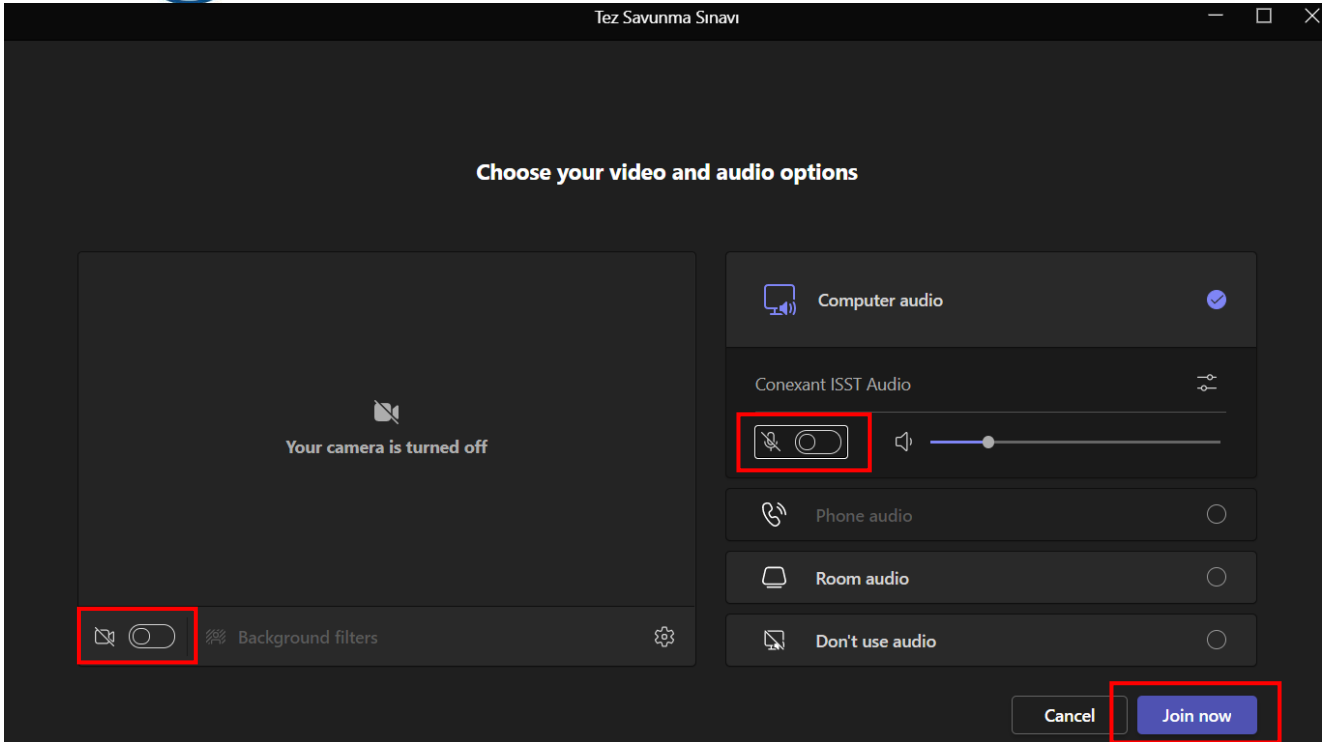


B. ONLINE MEETING

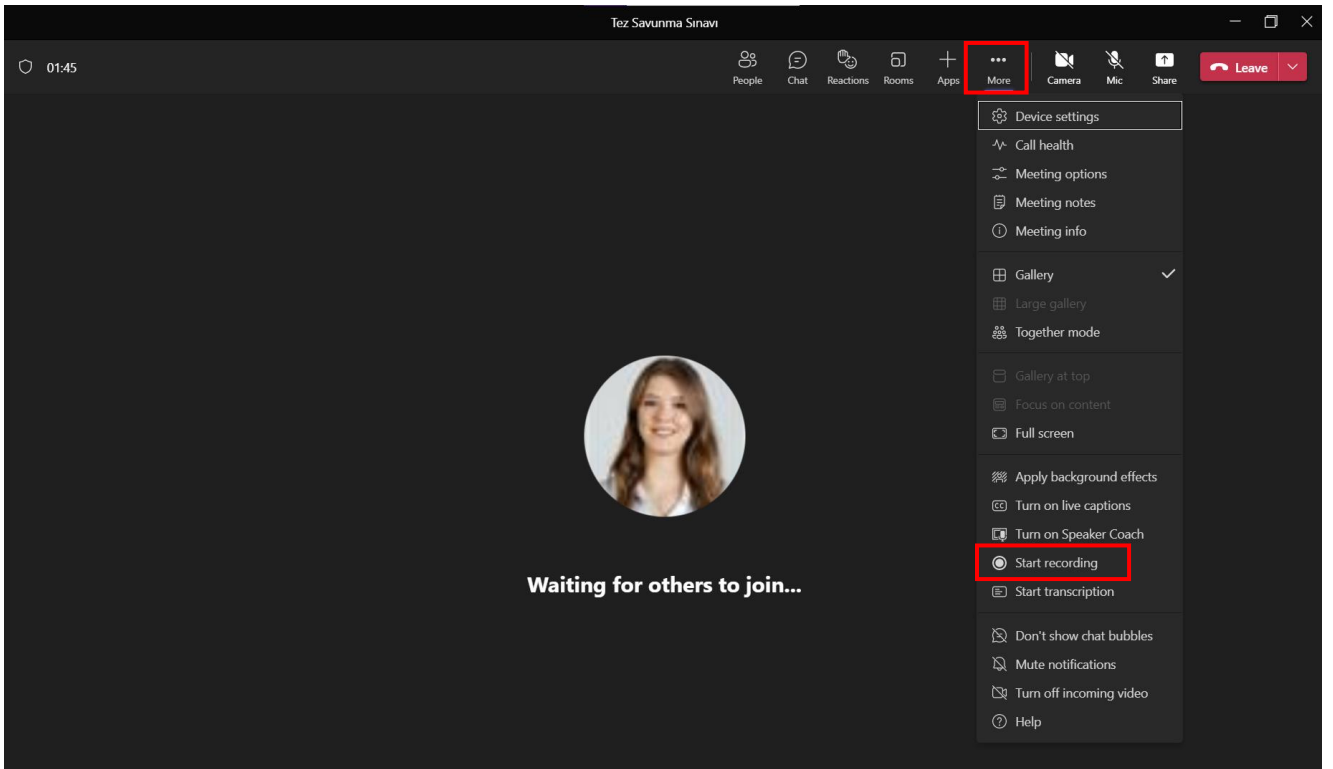
1. Students and jury/committee members can enter the meeting by clicking on the link provided to them. The advisor who creates the meeting link can enter the meeting via the "Outlook Calendar". Clicking once on the meeting in the calendar opens the "Calendar Tools-Meeting" page. You can enter the meeting with the "Join Teams Meeting" option here.

2. When the Microsoft Teams interface is opened, video and audio options are selected. After the necessary settings are made, the meeting is entered with the "Join Now" option.

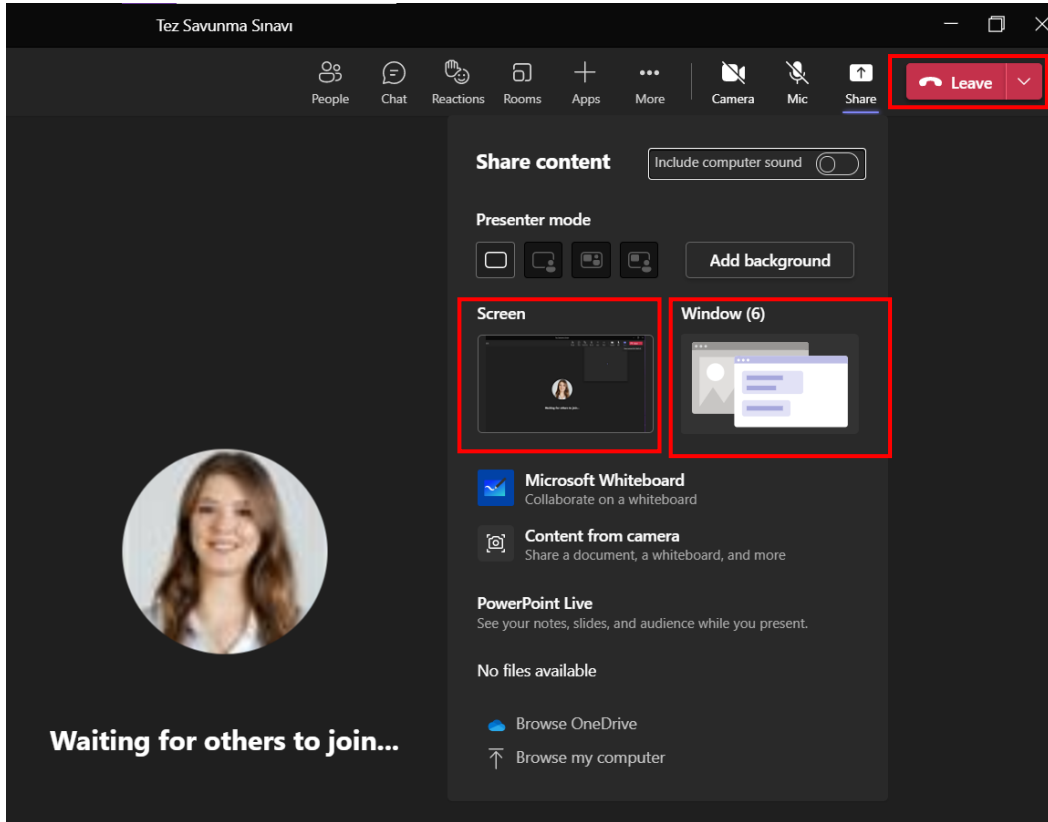


- When the meeting is started, the “Start recording” option should be selected by selecting “More” from the options above.

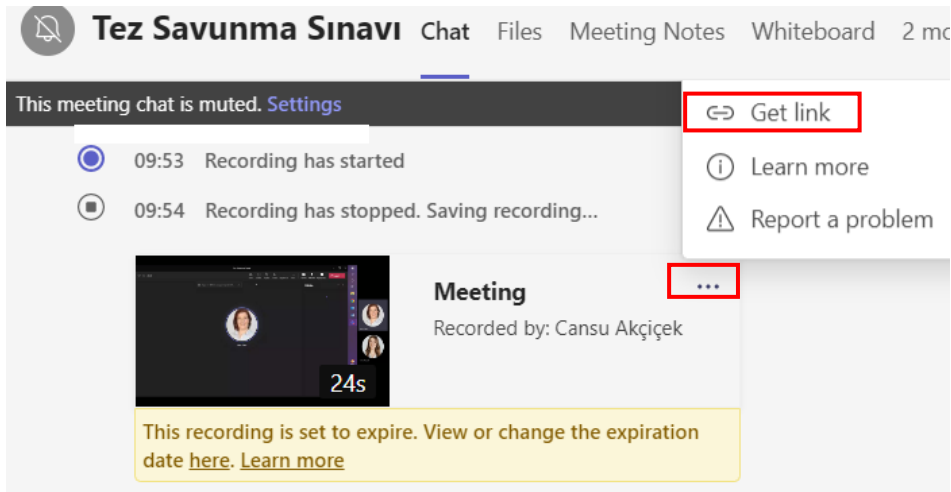




4. Screen sharing can be done by selecting "Screen" or "Window" to be shared over the "Share" option in the meeting.



5. After the meeting is over, you can exit the meeting by clicking the "Leave" button. The received recording is automatically saved on the Teams meeting chat page. Click on the "Get Link" option on the "... " symbol in the upper right corner of the meeting recording in the image below.



The record link that appears on the screen can be obtained with the "Copy" option. This record link should be written in the relevant place in the form prepared to be sent to the Graduate School.
